The Associate Parent Volunteer Scheme is subject to the conditions and rules as stated below. Please read them carefully before completing the form.

Terms and Condition of Parent Volunteer Scheme

1. The objective of the scheme is to encourage parents and the community to develop continuous personal involvement and commitment to the school.
2. Under this scheme, **a parent must give at least forty (40) hours of voluntary services to the school in the 12 months before the child is due for registration (i.e between July 2018 and June 2019).** All parents who have given at least 40 hours (or beyond) of voluntary service will be accorded the same priority in Phase 2B of the Primary One Registration Exercise. Child to be registered must be a Singapore Citizen / Singapore Permanent Resident (SPR).
3. The **closing date** for the submission of this application for parents whose child is due for registration in **2019** is on **30 June 2018**. **Photocopies of the parents' NRIC, the child's birth certificate and Re-entry permit (for child who are Singapore PR) must be submitted together with the application form.**
4. In the event that the number of applicants exceeds the vacancies available in Phase 2B, the school will comply with MOE's procedure and conduct balloting for all eligible applicants according to the P1 Registration Exercise policy. From 2012 Exercise onwards, when balloting is necessary, Singapore Citizens will be given absolute priority over Singapore Permanent Residents.
5. The School reserves the right to decide on the type of voluntary services it requires, based on the prevailing school needs and which it deems best suited in the interest of the school and its pupils.
6. The School will keep track of the number of voluntary hours rendered by each Associate Parent Volunteer.
7. **Acceptance of this application form does not render the school liable to accept the applicant until the Letter of Understanding has been agreed and signed.**
